Cool energy saving tips for every home.

By being smart with some quick tips and rules of thumb that anyone can implement for little or no expense, you'll make a big difference in your annual energy savings:

Home energy savings tips

- Nothing is more energy efficient than cooking with your microwave
- Do laundry efficiently by using the warm or cold water setting to wash clothes and always use cold water to rinse clothes (save 4%)
- Line dry clothes whenever you can (save up to 5%)
- When using the dryer, run full loads, use the moisture-sensing setting and clean the lint trap after each use (save 0.5%)
- Your dishwasher uses less water than washing dishes by hand — you conserve energy running your dishwasher only when fully loaded and turning off the dry cycle to air dry dishes instead (save 1%)
- Make sure that cooled air coming from A/C vents is not obstructed by furniture or draperies
- Don't place lamps or TV sets near your thermostat — the thermostat senses heat from these appliances causing A/C units to run longer than necessary



Home improvements that go a long way

- Install new storm windows and doors — there are many easy “do-it-yourself” options
- Replace old A/C units with newer, more energy-efficient units — newer equipment can save you up to 40% on your energy bills
- Seal leaks in attic ductwork so that cool air doesn't slip outside

Saving energy in the spring and the summer.

- Because A/C works hard to remove moisture from the air and reduce humidity inside your home, turn off air conditioning, or program your thermostat to a higher temperature, when not at home
- Minimize mid-day washing and drying of clothes, showering and cooking
- Turn on ventilating fans, but turn them off when not required so they don't extract cooled air from the house
- Set the temperature a little higher (around 78-80°F) to help save 6-8% of your cooling costs for each degree above 78° while remaining comfortable
- Shade your home from direct sunlight — use shades, drapes and awnings to block the sun from heating your home
